-PERFORMANCE NOTES-

The triangle notehead indicates pure air sound.

The semantic quality of the whispering is undefined as individual words should not be audible (to the audience.)

Air attack: there should be a significant amount of air sound before pitch emerges; it is fine (and even desirable) if this causes attacks across the ensemble to be unsynchronized at these sections.

The dotted arrow indicates a gradual transition between different playing techniques.

For the horn, the *aluminum foil* may be "hung" over the bell, so that the player may hold the instrument in the usual fashion.

For the trombone and tuba, the aluminum foil may be wrapped across the bell. For the latter, two sheets will be neccesary, and they may be placed over eachother in a cross pattern.

Harmonic glissandi, especially concerning the horn, should be left in just intonation and need not be adjusted to equal temperment.

Niente crescendo and decrescendo should involve an unpitched air attack/release

A $tremolo\ line$ between the + and \circ on the horn indicates an expressive microtonal pitch fluctuation via wavering between open and stopped horn.
